THE CITIZEN ASSEMBLY'S ENGAGEMENT WITH THE YOUTH ON THEIR RIGHTS AND QUEST FOR JUSTICE

The Law Society of Kenya in partnership with other key partners hosted the Citizen's Assembly which focused on empowering the youth with knowledge about their rights and fostering their quest for justice. This event was necessitated by the protests against the Finance Bill that had rocked the nation for the past two months.

The event provided a platform for the victims of police brutality who shared their first-hand account narratives and testimonials on the events that transpired during their abductions.

In addition, the key note address was issued by the LSK President Faith Odhiambo on, Amplifying Youth Engagement, activism and Justice for all victims. She stated that the event symbolizes not just a meeting of minds but a convergence of hopes, dreams, and the relentless pursuit of justice.

The youth are not merely the leaders of tomorrow; they are the changemakers of today and indeed we have all witnessed this. Their voices, vibrant and resolute, echo the demands for justice, equality and human rights. In every corner of our society, young people are stepping forward, challenging injustices, and striving to create a world that is fairer and more inclusive.

Other discussions focused on access to justice and the Bill of Rights and governance and accountability. Key speakers included; CJ (Rtd) Dr. Willy Mutunga, Mawna Hosea, LSK Council member, Irungu Houghton, Reuben Kigame and Cyprian Nyamwamu.

The events thereafter developed an action plan with clear cut timelines and milestones which will be shared with the membership in due course.

LSK STATEMENT ON THE ELECTION OF MR. JOHN CHEBOCHOK AS DIRECTOR OF TOROR TEA FACTORY

The Law Society of Kenya (LSK) is appalled by the recent election of Mr. John Chebochok as a director of the Toror Tea Factory, managed by the Kenya Tea Development Agency (KTDA). This election has sparked significant public outcry and raised serious questions about the integrity of the electoral process and the safeguarding of women's rights within the tea industry.

Mr. Chebochok was prominently featured in a BBC documentary aired in February 2023, titled "Sex for Work: The True Cost of Our Tea," which exposed egregious sexual exploitation practices within the tea industry. The documentary included undercover footage and survivor testimonies, leading to Mr. Chebochok's termination from James Finlays Limited and his subsequent barring from their properties. Despite these serious allegations and his dismissal, Mr. Chebochok was allowed to contest for and was elected to the position of director of the Toror Tea Factory on 29th June, 2024.

Hon. Justice David Shikomera Majanja, was a member of the Law Society of Kenya, having been admitted to the Bar on 12th March, 1998. He trained as a pupil and received instructions in the proper business, practice, and employment of an Advocate at Mohammed & Muigai Advocates. This was preceded by his graduation from the University of Nairobi on 9th December, 1996 with a Bachelor of Laws Degree.

2. How do I apply for my Practising Certificate?



Log into your portal and press the 'click to apply for my 2024 Practising Certificate' prompt on your dashboard. Proceed to fill in your declaration form then download and print it. Depending on what you have declared as your nature of engagement, the documents to be uploaded are as follows: -

For members practicing as Sole proprietors/Partners:

- a. A fully signed and witnessed declaration to accompany the application for PC.
- b. A valid professional indemnity cover.
- c. The accountant's certificate whereby the accounting period should be for the previous year e.g. 01-01-2023 to 31-12-2023 for PC application 2024.
- d. Certificate of registration of the firm.

For members practicing as Associates/In-house Counsel/Legal Officers/Company Secretaries/State Counsel/Academic:

- a. A fully signed and witnessed declaration to accompany the application for PC.
 - b. A duly filled, signed and commissioned statutory declaration form.
- NB The receipt shall only be issued once all the requisite documents have been uploaded on the portal.

3. How do I change or update my physical address?




