- ❖ CPD Charges are Kshs. 4,500 for a one-day seminar and Kshs. 8,000 for a two-day seminar. Advocates of 3 years and below (THE YOUNG LAWYERS) will pay Kshs. 3500 for a one-day seminar and Kshs. 6500 for a two-day seminar. For the two-day seminar in Malindi, Advocates of 3 years and below pay Kshs. 8500 while those of above 3 years pay Kshs. 12,000.
- ❖ All costs of CPD events are exclusive of Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) Value Added Tax (VAT).
- ❖ The Induction Course is compulsory for all newly admitted Advocates and shall earn the newly admitted Advocates (5) CPD Units.
- ❖ **Cancellation** or transfer of (payments) requests must be made in writing (e-mail or letter) and reach LSK office at least 24 hours before the date of the seminar. The amount paid is non-refundable but the funds can only be transferred to any upcoming event of your choice within the calendar year. Cancellations done after the expiry of 24 hours or after the event will not be granted.
