- ❖ This Calendar does not include Courses offered by independent accredited CPD providers.
- ❖ The Induction Course is compulsory for all newly admitted Advocates and shall earn the newly admitted Advocates (5) CPD Units.
- ❖ The presentations for the sessions on this calendar will be available to the membership on their online portals accessible through <https://online.lsk.or.ke/login>
- ❖ For all CPD events scheduled for two or more consecutive days, participants shall earn the full points only on attending all days.
- ❖ The registration desk at all CPD events will close 30 minutes after the scheduled time for the start of the event. The Committee shall strictly enforce the time limit to guarantee punctuality.
- ❖ Any member who attends events facilitated by other independent institutions accredited by the Law Society of Kenya shall be awarded the requisite CPD Unit(s) after the said institutions forwards the list of participants to the CPD Directorate accompanied by a fee of Kes. 1,000 for each participant.
- ❖ Any member who wishes to be exempted from attending CPD Events must make an application to the Law Society of Kenya giving reasons why they should be exempted and the application must be accompanied by documentary evidence and a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000/- for each application year.
- ❖ Any member wishing to present or facilitate at any of the above sessions should contact the CPD Directorate on the email cpd@lsk.or.ke. All CPD speakers are expected to submit to the Directorate a full text of their presentation (Microsoft word, 5000 words, well referenced with foot notes) within two weeks before making the presentation.

- ❖ The Deadline for payment of CPD events shall be as indicated, in the payment invoices issued upon booking by members.
